



CONSENT FORM TO PARTICIPATE IN NET-METERING PROGRAMME

1. Background Information

This programme includes the installation of Net-Energy Meter at the Participant premises or land by the Participant (hereby known as “**site**”) whereby the Participant gives consent to allow excess energy produced from the participant’s installed Solar Photovoltaic System to be exported back to the “Distribution Service Provider” (DSP) grid. Net-metering Programme is open for participation to the general public (residential, commercial and industrial sectors) and government sector. The application to participate in the programme will be in accordance with the processes and guidelines that have been set by the Ministry of Energy and the Department of Electrical Services.

2. Definitions

Terms and definitions used in this form:

2.1. Distribution Service Provider (“**DSP**”)

Hereby defined as the owner of the Grid, which is the Department of Electrical Services.

2.2. Meter

A DSP approved Net-Energy Meter that reads both import and export of energy from solar PV system to the grid and from the grid to the Participant’s premise.

2.3. Net-metering

A mechanism where an eligible consumer installs a Solar PV system primarily for his own use and any excess energy is exported to the DSP grid.

2.4. Participant

Owner of premise who has installed their Solar PV System (at their own premise) or intend to install Solar PV System, who wishes to participate in the Net-Metering Programme or has been selected by the Ministry of Energy to participate in the Programme.

2.5. Site

Location of the premise where the installation of meter for project is conducted.

3. Programme

3.1. Programme Definition

As defined in Paragraph 1, this programme is open to the general public (residential, commercial and industrial sectors) and government sector to participate and enroll in the Programme, by undergoing and complying all the processes and guidelines that have been set by the Ministry of Energy and the Department of Electrical Services, including but not limited to:

- Testing the effectiveness and robustness of Code of Practice for Small-Scale Solar Photovoltaic System Connection to Low Voltage Network,
- Improving and enhancing processes and procedures inclusively,
- To confirm and demonstrate scalability.

3.2. Post-programme

The participant will, by default, be enrolled into the Net-metering Programme.

3.3. Programme Participation

3.3.1. Eligibility for Participation

To be able to participate in this programme, the Participant shall fulfill the following conditions:

- a. To have and own existing Solar PV System installed at their premises, and to be the owner/lessor of the premises that had installed Solar PV System (Grid-tied).
- b. Or will be installing the solar PV System at their premises.
- c. Not make any alteration to their Solar PV System design or the solar system configuration that may affect the Meter or the reading of the Meter, without the consent of the Ministry of Energy.

3.3.2. Responsibilities of Participant

Participant who has agreed to be involved in the programme shall:

- a. Be responsible for all costs associated with purchasing and installing the Solar PV System.
- b. Allow the installation of the meter at their premises.
- c. Release and share data related to their Solar PV system and Net-Metering meter, and any other relevant information as requested by the Ministry of Energy.

Not commit any offences under Section 52 in the Electricity Act, Chapter 223. Any person is guilty of an offence under this Act is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$50,000, imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 years or both and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$250 for every day or part thereof during which the offence continues after conviction. **Disclaimer: The Ministry of Energy shall not be held responsible or liable for any issues in relation to the Participants' Solar PV System, including any issues or damages that may be caused in relation to the installation of the Meter.*
